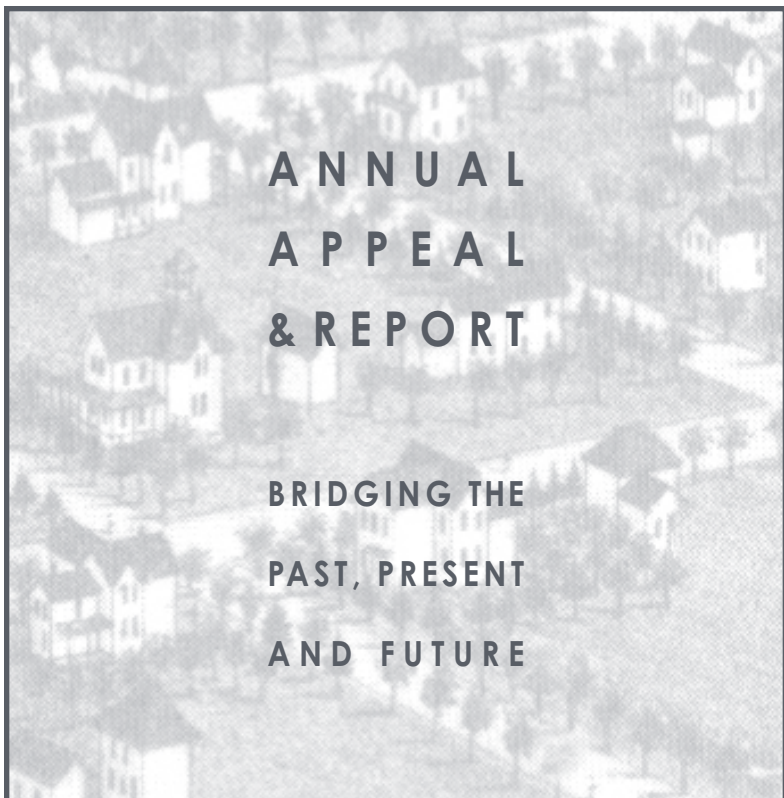

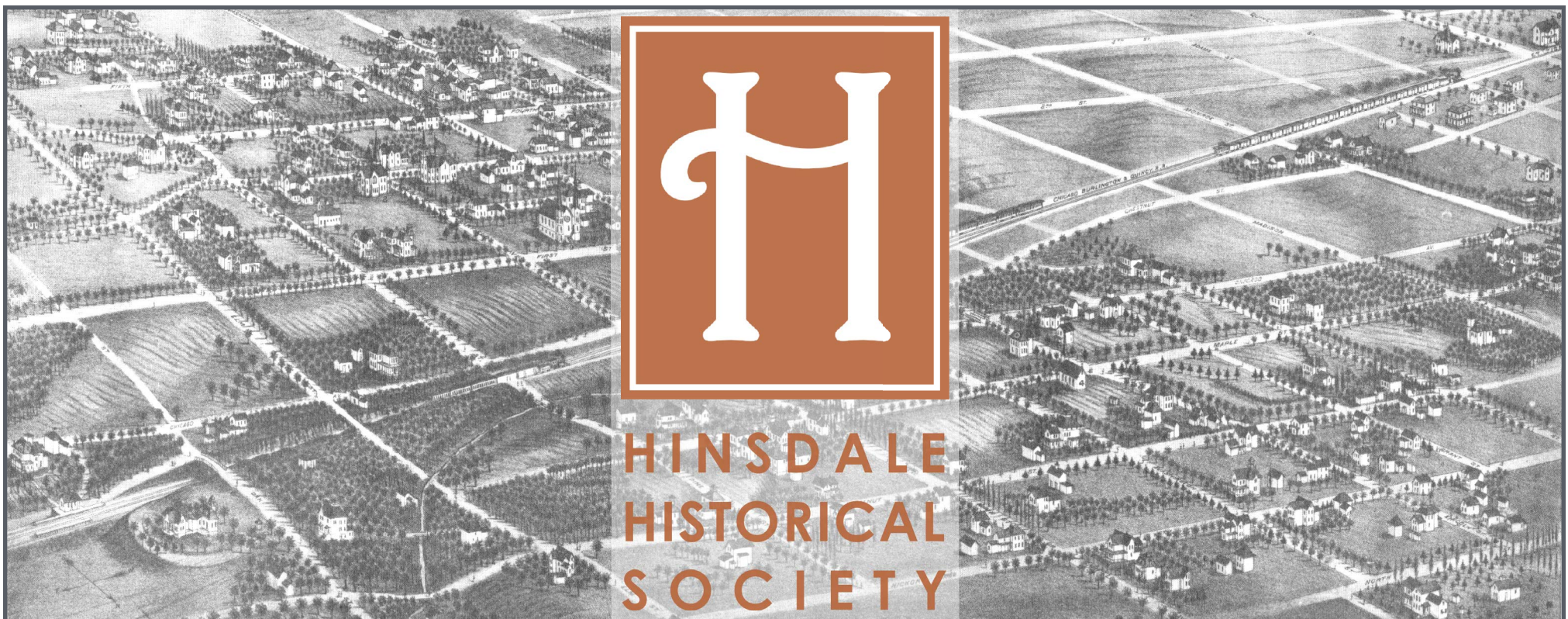

FOR OVER FORTY YEARS, THE HINSDALE HISTORICAL SOCIETY has been the main repository for Hinsdale's treasured history in addition to operating and maintaining three historic buildings in our Village. It is our mission to bridge the past, present, and future by engaging the community with its history and architecture. To achieve this mission, we are dedicated to collecting, preserving, and promoting history from the past and present through programming, exhibits, services, and friend-raising events.

As we make an appeal for your support, we'd like to share with you some of our achievements from the past year. It was an exceptional year for fundraising, membership, and volunteer involvement. Our signature event the *Hinsdale Cooks! Kitchen Walk*, organized and run by the Society's Women's Board, raised over \$73,000 and had over 850 in attendance. THE SOCIETY IS GOING MOBILE

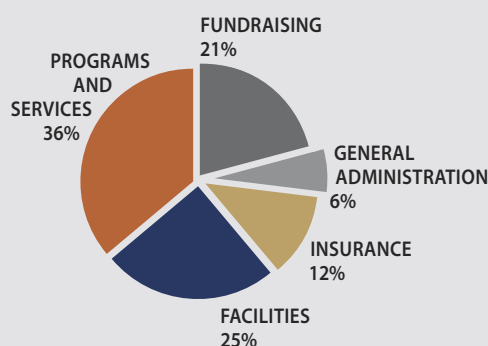
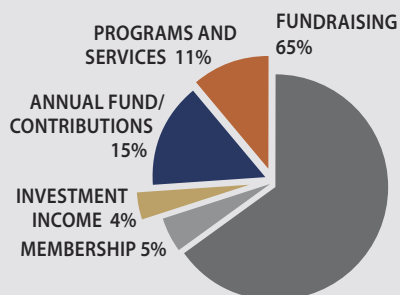
